

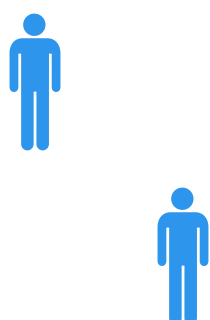
# COVID-19 and Safer Drug Use



Avoid sharing cigarettes, joints, pipes, injecting equipment, containers for alcohol, utensils and other supplies. If you have to share pipes wipe them with alcohol wipes or use new mouthpieces.



Carry naloxone and have an overdose plan. Please use breathing masks available in the Take Home Naloxone kits if responding to an overdose.



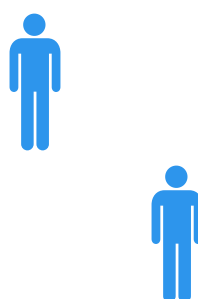
Reduce close contact - (e.g. shaking hands, hugging, kissing) - try to stay two metres apart (more than arm's length).



Use an overdose prevention site or supervised consumption site when available.



Prepare your drugs yourself. Wash your hands or use wipes before preparing, handling or using your drugs.



Avoid using alone - use with a buddy but stay two metres apart unless responding to an overdose.



Clean surfaces with soap and water, alcohol wipes, bleach or hydrogen peroxide before preparing drugs if possible.



Cough or sneeze into your elbow or use tissues. Throw tissues away immediately and wash your hands thoroughly.



Wash your hands often.
